This week our class has worked on word families such as */Ben, hen, ten, men, pen, den/* and */bed, fed, Ned, led, Ted, Ed, red/.* Many of the boys and girls can read these words and spell them so ask your child to give it a try – this would be GREAT practice for building pre-reading skills! We have been singing the fun songs "Edgar the Elephant", "Green Eggs and Ham", and "Echo Song". We have reviewed and introduced many readiness skills this week to help better prepare us for reading. We have had an excellent time with Ms. E!

Well, we shared this week with two other fun letter people Ms. W and Ms. Y. What a wild week! We have been very busy this week learning all about Ms. W and her wonderful words—short words, long words, happy words, sad words, color words, rhyming words. Ms. Y with her very special yodeling yawn also arrived. Some of the boys and girls are very good yodelers! We have learned that if we need to yawn we must do it politely – by covering our mouth as we yawn quietly. WOW what a busy week! Keep looking and listening for "e's", "w's" and "y's" all around you! In math class we have worked on the following skills:

- Learning solid figures
- Identifying cube, cylinder, cone and sphere
- Describing shapes in the environment
- More position of shapes
- Describing the position of shapes in the environment

Please continue to practice on counting to 100! Next Thursday is our big 100 Day Celebration. Yesterday I sent notes hope asking for donation to help with the big day.
