Dear Kindergarten Parents,

well this week we have worked hard on mastering all those important skills we discussed at parent/teacher conferences a couple of weeks ago. We have reviewed the letters Mm, Ss, Nn, Aa, Bb, Tt, Pp, Cc, Rr and Ii along with their sounds in initial, medial and/or final positions in words. we have also worked hard on reading predictable, decodable and leveled readers. Lots of the boys and girls are doing a great job with their fluency in reading these readers. To reinforce these letters we have read literature with all of these letters in the titles. We have read such fun books as Panda Bear, Panda Bear What Do You See?, Raven A Trickster Tale From the Pacific Northwest, Baby Bear, Baby Bear What Do You See? and Naughty Little Monkeys. we have practiced our sight words and learned four new ones: she, look, so and no. We have worked on our handwriting, practiced sounding out CVC words, listened for rhyming words and read lots of books. We concluded this week with our Unit 1 assessment. Some students continue to need help with these skills so please continue to help your child at home.

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We also took this week to review in math. We specifically focused on number recognition and writing for the numbers D-1D. We sequenced numbers, figured out the missing numbers, counted groups to write the correct number, worked on numbers that are one more than the given number and worked on patterns. Once again there are students that have not mastered these skills and need extra practice. PLEASE practice with your kindergartener at home.

Well as you know the weather is getting much colder. Students need to come to school prepared for the cold weather!! Please help your child be ready for riding the bus and for recess outdoors during these cold and windy days! Thanks so much!
