Has your child been particularly interested in "m" and "t" things? I hope so! We have had a marvelous and terrific week working on the letters Mm and Tt. Each student should now be able to recognize upper case and lower case, write and hear the sounds at the beginning and end of words for the letter Mm and Tt. We have learned all this from Mr. M who has a "munching mouth" and Ms. T with her "tall teeth". Mr. M likes meatballs, mashed potatoes, macaroni, marshmallows, muffins, milk and much, much more! Mr. M even brought mini-marshmallows for us to munch on Monday! Ms. T has taught us about taking good care of our teeth. We also discussed things that can go into our mouths and things that should not. During this week we have been singing and acting out the songs "Old MacDonald Had A Farm" and "A Tisket. A Tasket". We have read the books If You Give A Mouse A Cookie. Animal Mouths. Meet Me At the Market. The Mystery of Magnets, Old MacDonald Had a Farm, and *The Giving Tree*. On Tuesday we made and explored magnets and learned many interesting things about magnets. On Thursday we created a class book entitled "Ten Dots" and the students did a great job using their imaginations. Today we had fun illustrating Tiny Books. As this semester moves along, please continue to review the "Mm" and "Tt" letters and their sounds with your child.
