We learned that Mr. Q has a very good friend that stands next to him in most "q" words and that is Ms. U. We read three excellent books entitled <u>Little</u> <u>Quack</u>, <u>The Quiltmaker's Gift</u> and <u>The Quiet Book</u>. We discussed questions and question marks. We know we can learn a lot by asking questions and listening! Yesterday we colored a paper quilt square to put into "Our Class Quilt Album".
